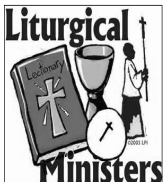

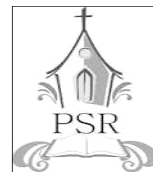

Can you spare an hour to be with Jesus in the Eucharist?

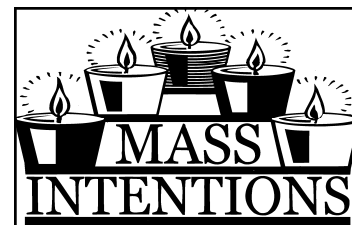
