# Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Luke 22 : 14 — 23 : 56



We begin Holy Week. Palm Sunday is probably the last good day in the life of Christ. Jesus will be accused both by the Roman and Jewish leaders that he is a menace and threat to their temporal and spiritual power. His suffering and death contradicts their claims where he asks his followers to forgive their enemies and commends his soul to his Father. No way did he entice retaliation or organized revolts. He died the way he lived, the greatest pacifist who ever lived.




